## **Shifting linguistic landscape**

Number of Internet users accessing the web mainly in Chinese will overtake Internet users using predominantly English by 2015

### Loud and social online

1/2 of all active Internet users access social networks

#### **Mobile broadband**

Smartphones offer access to an online world of apps, with powerful potential for achieving the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs)

## **Internet of Things**

By 2020, connected devices may outnumber connected people by a ratio of 6:1

# GLOBAL BROADBAND ADVOCACY TARGETS 2015

## Making broadband policy universal

119 countries have a National Broadband Plan by mid-2012, with 12 Plans in formulation

## Connecting homes to broadband

20.5% of households in developing countries had Internet access at end 2011 on track to achieve 2015 target

## **Making broadband affordable**

Fixed broadband cost less than 5% of monthly income in 48 developing economies in 2011 - up from just 35 in 2010

## **Bringing people online**

1/3 of the world's population is now online, but greater effort is needed to extend Internet access and achieve 2015 target
